Through funding from the European Commission's Recovery and Resilience Facility, Croatia will install 1,300 charging stations for electric vehicles. 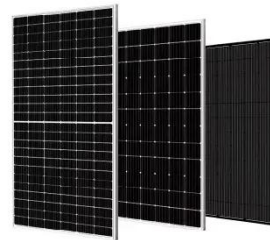
